With reference to your application dated 10.01.2025 on the
above subject, and on the basis of the scrutiny made in this
regard, I, Nikhil Bhuyar, Education Officer (Pri.) Zilla Parishad,

Nagpur, hereby grants provisional sanction for the period from 01.04.2025 to dated 31.3.2028 for a period of 3 years for 1st to 8th standards of K.D.K. International School, Butibori, district Nagpur (English medium).

The above approval / sanction shall be subject to fulfillment of compliances:

1. The period of sanction will not be extended and it will not be binding to grant sanction after 8th standard under any circumstances.
2. The school will comply with the provisions of Maharashtra Right of Free and compulsory Education Act, 2009 (Annexure one) and Maharashtra Right of Free and compulsory Education Act, 2011 (Annexure two).
3. The boys of group of physically challenged or neglected group will be given admission in 1st standard subject to limit of 25% and they will be given free and compulsory education and this parameter will also be applicable to the pre-primary classes.

4. For the students prescribed under Schedule 3 will be fulfilled and for this fulfillment a separate bank account will be got opened.
5. The school will not take any capitation fee and will not compel the students or their mother-father to pay for any scrutiny purpose.
6. No admission in the school will be refused on account of non-availability of proof of age, religion, caste, place of birth for any reasons amongst these.
7. (1) the boy given in the standard in the school will not be detained and will not be terminated till the completion of primary education;
(2) No physical or mental trouble will be given to the student.
(3) It will not be necessary to give board exam till he completes primary education;
(4) Every student will be issued certificate prescribed under rule on completion of his primary education;
(5) The handicapped /specially challenged students will be absorbed as per provisions of the Act.

(6) The teachers possessing qualification as prescribed under Section 23(1) will be appointed. However, However, the commencement of the Act, the qualification prescribed therein, the teachers will be required to acquire minimum qualification within 5 years.

(7) The teachers will perform his/her duties prescribed u/s 24(1).

(8) It may kindly be ensured by the school that the teachers will not involve themselves in private tuition

(8) The school will implement the syllabus prescribed by School Tribunal.

(9) The students will be admitted considering the facilities available in the school.

10. The school will implement the parameters and guidelines as prescribed under Section 19 of the School Code. During inspection, the following facilities were available in the school

1. Area of the school premises : 69X17.7 Sq. ft.

2. Total constructed area: 16500 Sq. ft.

3. Area of playground of the school: 16500 Sq. meters.
4. Total number of rooms in the school 14 class rooms:-8
5. Office, Store, Headmaster: Available.
6. Independent lavatory for boys and girls: Sufficient water available for cleaning lavatories for boys and girls (Lavatory for boys-1 and urinal -3)(Lavatory for girls-1 and urinals -04.)
7. Drinking Water facilities: Available.
8. Kitchen for preparing food : Available.
9. Availability of material for studies/ games, sports, Library-Available.
10. Reading literature other than science (number of books 150) library is available.
11. Whether all facilities without obstacle is available: Yes.
12. Whether protection wall is available? Yes.
11. The sections and classes which are not recognized will not be permitted to run in the school.
- 12.The school building and other construction or playground and skill development will be only used.

13. The expenses are incurred by the society as per School Society Registration Act, 1860 (21 of 1860) and Mumba Public Trusts Act, 1950.

14. The school is not administered for benefit of any persons group or for any other person's benefit.

15. The balance sheet should be got audited and certified by any Auditor and audit report should be prepared and made ready as per rules. A copy of each audit report should be submitted to Education Officer.

16. The code for your school is 27090902941. This code may be mentioned while making correspondence with this office.

17. The school will submit the report and information as and when demanded by Director of Education/ Education Officer from time to time and for continuation of approval to the school and for complying with the conditions or removing deficiencies and will comply with the notices issued by local authority.

18. If any renewal of registration of the society, the renewal may be ensured.

19. Other conditions are furnished in enclosure three.

20. As per Right of Free and compulsory Education of the students, the necessary the necessary compliance of the deficiencies may be removed by 31.3.2028 otherwise the sanction of your school will automatically come to an end.
